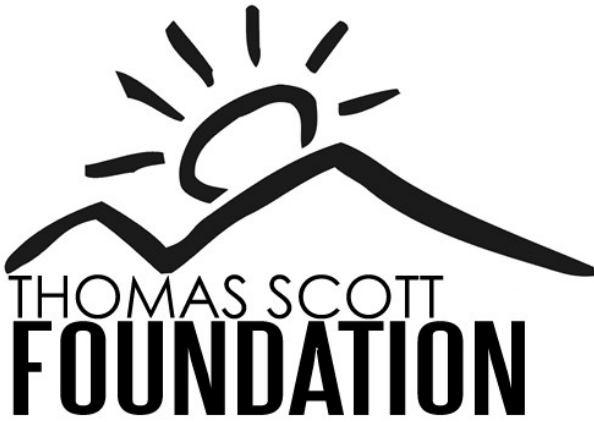

Welcome to the 7th anniversary Thomas Scott Memorial Golf Tournament! We hope you enjoy the tournament!

- USPGA rules will apply unless otherwise noted.
- Format: 2 person scramble. Each person hits his or her ball every time from the tee box. The team then will select the best shot and everyone will play their next ball from there. A team can improve their lie by no more than one club length and cannot improve their lie once the ball is on the green.
- Please respect the course, other golfers, and all volunteers at all times.
- Men shall utilize the blue tees while the women will shoot from the red tees unless otherwise instructed or Texas Tees are utilized.
- Putting for Coconuts Hole: Hole #18. To participate in the longest putt contest, participants must don the Hawaiian garb they choose not to treat the hole like any other. Longest putt wins a prize...and a coconut.
- Texas Tee Hole: Hole # 10. \$5 buy-in. All players will tee off from the gold tees unless they buy-in for Texas Tees. If Texas Tees are utilized, men tee off from the red tee while women tee off from the 150 yard marker!
- Set of Irons Hole: Hole #13. Hole in one wins the prize. Must be witnessed.
- Paradise Vacation Hole/Closest to the Pin Hole: Hole #17. Hole in one wins the \$5000 vacation package. Closest to the hole without getting a hole in one wins the Wendover Hotel and Golf vacation package.
- Dell PC Hole: Hole #8. Hole in one wins the prize. Must be witnessed.
- Bose Stereo Hole: Hole #4. Hole in one wins the prize. Must be witnessed.
- Mulligans are welcome on any hole excluding the Vacation Hole and all Par 3 holes. Mulligans are 2 for \$5 and there is a two mulligan per golfer limit.
- All judgments or interpretations of the rules are reserved for Thomas Scott Foundation members and Spring Creek Golf Course staff. All judgments or rulings are final.
- The primary goal and number 1 rule is to enjoy yourself, have a good time and raise funds to support a great cause. Prizes will be given for Longest Drive. Last place team will receive a special prize. Prizes will be given to 1st thru 3rd place teams with the lowest gross and net.
